The Eastern Washington Section of the American Nuclear Society is committed to encouraging students to enter the field of nuclear science and technology and to advancing the careers of young nuclear professionals. Up to three \$1,000 scholarships for tuition are available. Applicants must have completed a minimum of two years in an accredited undergraduate program by June 2016 and be enrolled full time in a four-year college or university in the U.S. In addition, graduate students in their first or second year of graduate study, who are enrolled full time, are eligible to apply. Applicants must be planning a career in nuclear science, nuclear engineering or a nuclear-related field. Note that the EWS-ANS chapter scholarships for the most part, are restricted to schools in Washington, Idaho and Oregon, exceptions will be considered on a case by case basis.

Scholarship recipient(s) will be notified by August 15, 2016. However, the scholarship will not be awarded until proof of enrollment in a classes for the 2016-2017 school year has been provided.

Please read carefully:

The scholarship application, copy of official transcript, letter(s) of reference and current resume must all be emailed together as a complete packet. Incomplete packets will not be considered. **Applications must be emailed by 11:59pm PST on April 30, 2016 to be considered.** Submissions that are received via mail, or hand delivery will be reviewed at the discretion of the committee. It is strongly encouraged that all packets are submitted electronically.
